

School of Nursing, Christian Hospital, Mungeli

1. Beginnings

Christian Hospital Mungeli was started in 1896 by missionaries of the Disciples of Christ, USA. It was at one time a very famous hospital for eye work and thrived till about 1947 after which the hospital had many years of difficulty. Since 2003, the hospital has once again started growing and is today a 120 bedded institution which examines more than 40,000 outpatients, operates on about 3,500 and delivers about 700 babies a year. The hospital also runs the Rambo Memorial English School which brings in about 1000 children from all the surrounding villages. We in Mungeli strive to give medical care and education to all at the most affordable cost but remembering not to compromise in any way. Therefore, we have the state of the art equipment and provide the best of services always, remembering the poor and the marginalized as they are our focus and attention at all times.

2. Philosophy

Health is a basic right of every human being. The progress of our country depends on its citizens being healthy. The Christian Hospital Mungeli believes that nurses can play a vital role in promoting physical, emotional, and spiritual health and healing. Nursing is both science and art, the essence of which is nurturing and caring. On receiving a high standard of education and training, young women who become responsible, competent professional nurses and ethically sound individuals, are able to help restore and maintain the health of persons in both the hospital and community with a spirit of compassion and concern as per the ideals and values of Christian service. The School of Nursing can empower women of this area to contribute excellent services toward the development of human resources required to improve the quality of life in this rural area.

3. Aim

The whole community of the Christian Hospital, Mungeli is committed to providing holistic health care through excellent service, quality care, and respectful treatment in which the dignity and spirituality of each person is honored. The aim of the School of Nursing is to develop well qualified nurses who are committed to excellence in the practice of nursing and who assist in meeting the objectives of the hospital /community in the love and spirit of Christ.

4. Objectives

On successful completion of the course a student will be able to:

1. Plan for and give comprehensive nursing care and health guidance to individuals and families according to their needs.
2. Administer quality care and respectful treatment with the spirituality of each person to be honored.
3. Administer holistic health care to persons in the community and hospital.
4. Assist in the relief of suffering, promotion of healing and health, and in prevention of disease in the spirit of Christ for service to all persons in need, regardless of caste, creed, color or religion.
5. Identify and react to significant health and social needs of the community. Be an honest, responsible citizen and ideal role model in our society.

5. Affiliation

The School of Nursing, Christian Hospital Mungeli is affiliated to the Mid India Board of Education (MIBE) of the Nurses League of the Christian Medical Association of India (CMAI) and is recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.

6. Course offered and eligibility

1. General Nursing-Midwifery (GNM) – A 3 year course in basic adult and child maternal health nursing which is institution and community oriented. Minimum qualification required – Higher Secondary School (12th pass) with an aggregate of 40% marks, 5% marks relaxation for SC/ST candidates (Proof to be attached).
2. Age – The candidates should have completed 17 years & be less than 35 years by October 1, to join the course.
3. Admission is open for female candidates, generally single.
4. As nursing involves much communication – knowledge of both written and spoken Hindi and English is compulsory for candidates who apply.

7. PROGRAMME INFORMATION

- a. The training course begins on or about October 1st each year. Textbooks are in English and instruction will be in English and Hindi.
- b. Days lost due to long illness or other reason will have to be made up at the end of the course. One month vacation will be granted each year at a time convenient to the hospital. A maximum of 10 days sick leave is allowed per year on certificate from a physician of the Christian Hospital Mungeli.
- c. At the end of the first four months of training the student should pass the PTS exam.
- d. Students whose fees are up to date and who make the minimum grade in internal assessment (at six months) will be eligible to apply for the MIBE annual examination.
- e. Students will not be permitted to continue the course if they:
 - i. Do not make minimum grade in internal assessment.
 - ii. Require disciplinary action.
 - iii. Are found medically or psychiatrically unfit by CHM medical officer.
- f. When necessary, the hospital authorities reserve the right to extend the training period and /or service year for disciplinary reasons. Any one whose conduct is unsuitable for nursing or who is not keeping within the discipline of this institution may be expelled with or without notice.
- g. Christian Hospital does not guarantee employment for those passing out from this institution.

8. GNM application/Entrance test

1. The Pre Nursing Test (PNT) is administered by the Mid India Board of Education of NL, CMAI Nagpur. You may choose any center of your convenience as given in the LIST OF Test Centers.
2. The application form is to be filled up and sent with Xerox copies of documents required. The hall ticket will be dispatched on receipt of the completed application form and amount.
3. Things to be brought for the test – Hall ticket, a plain Clip Board, HB pencil, sharpner and eraser.
4. The results will be sent by post. (If one is not called for interview, the candidate may further contact any other MIBE School of nursing for a vacancy.

9. Admission procedure

1. Those who are called/qualify for the interview shall submit original and Xerox copies of all certificates and make a payment of Rs. 1200/- towards physical examination and investigations (which includes X-Ray, Lab tests, Hepatitis B vaccination, Physical checkup, etc.) immediately after the selection in order to hold her seat.
2. The selected candidates who are cleared by physical checkup will be admitted. The parents or legal guardians must accompany the candidate on the day of admission.
3. The wait-listed candidates are requested to please check their position with the Principal before leaving.
4. Those candidates who are not selected may contact any other MIBE school of nursing for seat vacancies. Kindly keep your Pre-Nursing test result for the same.

THE DECISION OF THE SELECTION COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL

10. Fees

Christian Hospital, Mungeli provides quality nursing education to develop nurses who are strong in theory and in practice. During the study course, CHM subsidizes the cost of education to make it affordable even to students from economically weak families. The Christian Hospital Mungeli pays the difference of the actual cost and the subsidized amount as an educational subsidy loan to each student, which is to be repaid after the study course, preferably through service.

Fees may be paid as a lump sum. At admission, the student has to pay at least the minimum fees, as specified in the selection letter. Monthly fees has to be paid before the 15th of each month. A late fee of Rs. 10/- per month will be levied for delay in payment.

Fees are not refundable, and may be revised from time to time.

During the course, if a student desires to leave, the candidate and /or guardian will have to pay the entire unsubsidized fees to CHM.

11. SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME / WORK EXPERIENCE

After the study course, on successful completion, we give first preference to our students to avail of the two year work experience, to strengthen the practical skills and capacity. During this period, the candidates are part of the CHM continuing nursing education programme. At the successful completion of two years, a skills development / work experience certificate will be awarded. In this way, the student repays through service the educational subsidy that CHM contributed in their study course. During this period the transcripts are made and Diploma from the MIBE and the registration certificate from the CSNRC is obtained.

If a graduate does not undertake the skills development / work experience period or discontinues/ is terminated for any reasons, the candidate and her guardian will have to refund to the Christian Hospital the entire sum of the outstanding education subsidy loans.

12. HOSTEL

All students are to reside in the Nurses' Hostel and should abide by the Hostel and Hospital rules and regulations. Normally only parents are permitted to visit students. Any other visitor should bring written permission signed by the parent. All visitors must obtain written permission from the Principal of the School of Nursing before meeting the student. For male visitors, permission may be considered, only if he brings a letter from the parents authorizing the visit. Visitors are not permitted to enter the Hostel nor to meet another girl than the one for

whom permission is obtained. No student may meet visitors while on duty or during class. The guardian of each student must give a list of five approved names from whom the student may receive and send letters. Students have to submit family photo along with photos of visitors.

All to and from messages, letters, and money orders will be screened by the nursing school office. Generally no telegrams or telephone messages will be accepted on behalf of the students. Students are not permitted to keep mobile phones. Phone is provided with the warden for their use. It is compulsory for all candidates to stay in hostel during study and skill development programme. If a candidate gets married in that case she will be expelled from the hostel.

13. Examination/Diplomas/ Registration

The qualifying examinations are conducted by the MIBE in English and Hindi. Successful candidates who have also completed all requirements (in theory and practical) will be issued diplomas by the MIBE and then can be registered under the State Nursing Council.

14. Religious activity

We have chapel service every morning between 7.30am and 8.00am. Bible class will be held weekly. The Disciples CNI Church in Mungeli has its service every Sunday morning.

15. Ragging

Any student facing ragging or any such behavior after admission may immediately report the same to the Warden or nursing faculty in the hostel or the Principal, who will take it up with the anti-ragging committee. All students are to submit a declaration letter that if found guilty of ragging, she /he will be suspended from the institution.

16. Recreation

The various recreation facilities of the hostel are as follows: indoor games, television, badminton, and cultural programs. The student Nurses' Association meets once a month for a time of fellowship.

17. Engagement/Marriage

In case any student gets married during the period of the training, she will not be allowed to continue her training and she will be required to refund the entire amount spent on her by the School.

18. Terms

Terms set forth are subject to alterations, additions and variations as may be made from time to time by the Nursing School authorities whenever they may deem it expedient or necessary or in order to comply with M.I.B.E. requirements.
